

Permco does not currently support installation of this program on Windows Vista, however the following information may help you get the Permco BOM software up and running if you are using Windows Vista. There is no time table for a compatible release, however we are working on it. When a compatible version is available, it will be posted on the website and this disclaimer will be removed.

The most important difference between Windows Vista and previous versions is in the activation process for the Permco BOM software. **You MUST install and activate the program AS THE Windows USER WHO WILL BE RUNNING IT and this user must have administrative rights during the installation and activation process.** You do not need administrator rights to run the program once it has been installed and activated. If you don't log into your PC with a user name and password, or you always use the same user name and password and have admin rights, then you are fine. If you have multiple users, then this becomes more of an issue.

Obtain a copy of the latest setup file (setup.exe) from the Permco website at;

The file you want is the larger of the two, which is the full install of the program. You can either select to save the program or to run it. If you select to run it, follow the prompts to install. If you selected to save it, once the download is complete you can run the installation program by double clicking on the file called setup.exe and following the prompts to install. If you don't have fast Internet access, call Permco and we can mail you a CD.

The first time you run the program, it should ask you to activate. In order to show pricing, the program needs to be activated. This is done with a file called "activate" which has to be provided by Permco and cannot be downloaded from the website. When prompted to activate, browse to the activate file provided by Permco and select open. You should now have pricing.
